- 7 partner states: A, CH, D, F, FL, I and SI
- Total programme budget: 135 Mio €
- Max co-funding rate 76% ERDF
- The Alpine Space Programme 2007-2013 aims at:

"increasing competitiveness and attractiveness of the cooperation area by developing joint actions in fields where transnational cooperation is required for sustainable solutions".
